

January Minutes

OPR PAC MEETING

Thursday, January 10, 2019

- Meeting is called to order by K. Cerrato and she led the pledge of allegiance
- Motion to accept Nov minutes made by Laura Hearn, seconded by Kathy Martinez and all in favor.

- **Walpole Scholarship Foundation Presentation by Denise Lynch**

The scholarships are available to any Walpole resident and so far they have helped over 2900 students awarding over 3 million dollars. A lot of fundraising goes into it being able to support this foundation. This year they will hold their second annual cornhole tournament. Last year it brought the whole community together and Denise passed along the info for this year to be held on the 26th of January. Also an idea for everyone to keep in mind is a memorial to set up a scholarship for someone. Last year was more than 200,000 in awards were given and they hope to be able to match that this year. The Walpole Scholarship Foundation is on social media for families to follow along and see their current events.

- **Wall Ball Update with Marc Romeo**

- After Marc and the board entered an agreement for him to take the lead on building a wall ball he visited various sites for wall balls and saw many walls and 95% are concrete. He wanted to try and fundraise and logistically come up with a plan for a cement one, however, Kerri communicated to Marc that the Board wanted to go back to the original plan of wooden.
- Once the original plan was reestablished Marc presented plans to the Board. His plans included:
 - The wall would have an expectancy slighter longer than wood would typically last.
 - Reverberation effect if not insulated so we will insulate.
 - Panels can be replaced individually at a cost of approximately 100 dollars each.
 - Marc said he has a team in place to start digging holes first week of March and hopefully done by the end of March. The location is marked out for the lower black top to the right. Since funding right now will only cover a one sided wall the plan is to close off the back to enclose the insulation but leaving it with the option for the other side space wise.
 - Only caveat is the coatings are weather dependent but it won't prevent them from using it.
 - Marc has contacted both Nature works and Murphy for the concrete work.
 - Posts need to go into the ground but hopefully won't need bracing.
 - Liz Scott asked him how he could commit to a timeline when he does not know what other projects those companies have lined up. He reiterated that one of them would be available and again verbally committed to March and the original payment plan.

Omega man kicks off Feb 11th with themes including super hero!

2nd grade STEM is scheduled for next week.

Mr. Barner is currently looking for a quote for an irrigation system for the school garden.

He is also looking for a science volunteer to go through and inventory and replace the consumables and if any parent is interested please reach out to him.

School improvement plan for global awareness will include whole school events. More details to come in February.

The 2018 annual report is complete with a highlight about PAC events.

Reading Incentive program LOL went home for grades K-2.

Battle of the Books teams commenced today with the "Battles" scheduled in Feb and March.

The Great Kindness challenge begins Jan 28th. It will last a full week with a "kindness activity" each day and list of other kindness things you can do. Any child that participates will be entered to win a raffle prize at the end of the week.

Providence Bruins forms are due tomm. 36 tickets sold so far.

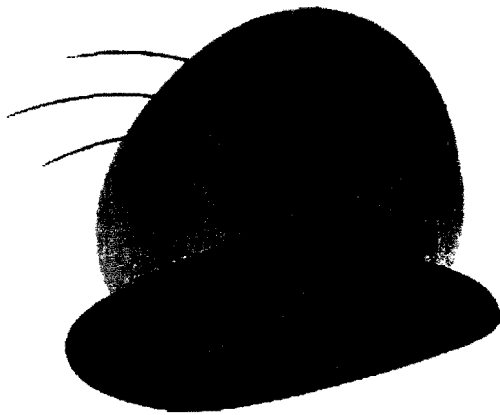
Feb 15th will be the next SOHD and parent volunteers are needed.

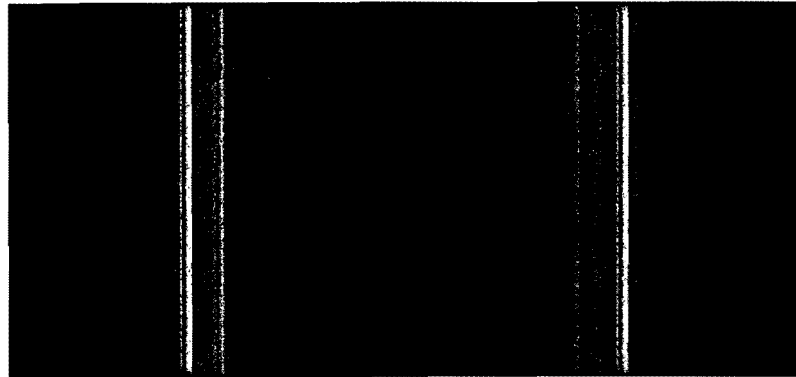

Old Post Road School Wall-Ball Project

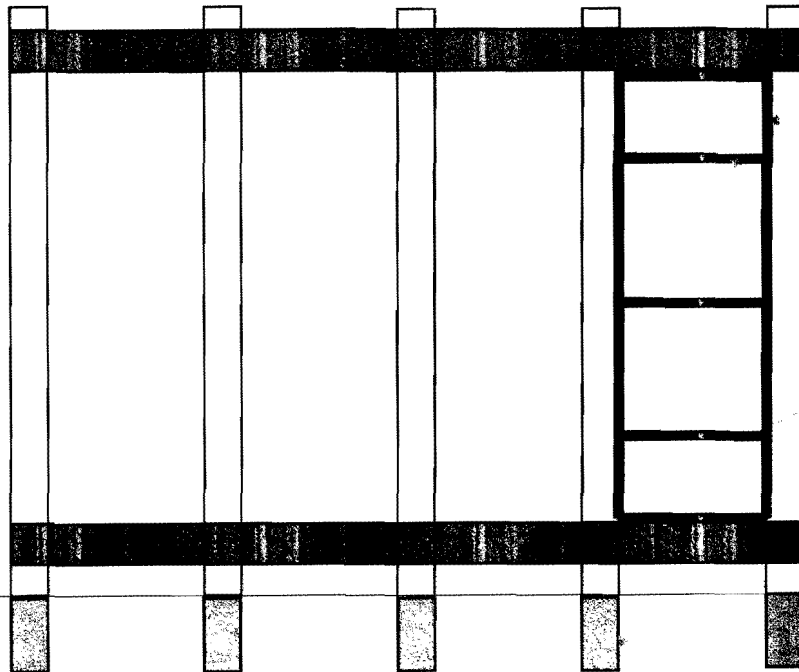

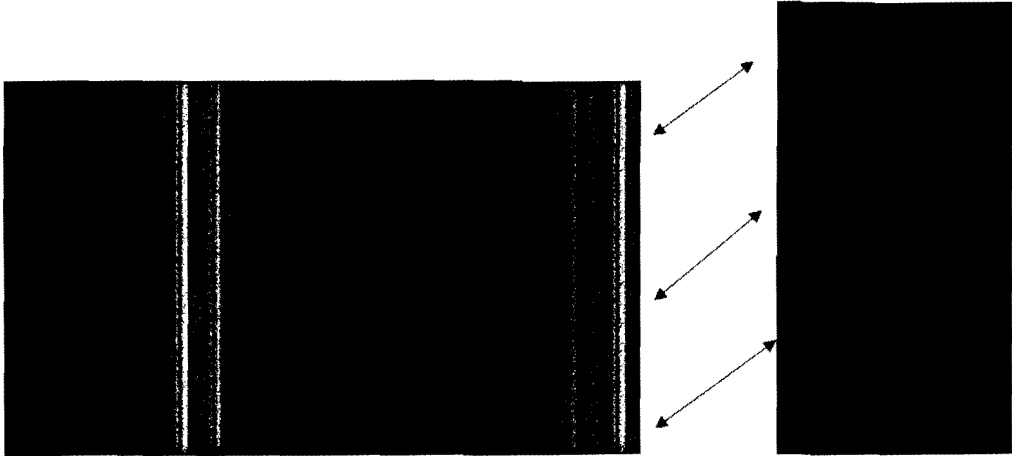

Panel Side View

4x8 sheet 1/2" MDF

- Finished on all sides
- Front Finish durable weather resistant high strength covering to resist moisture and wall use damage

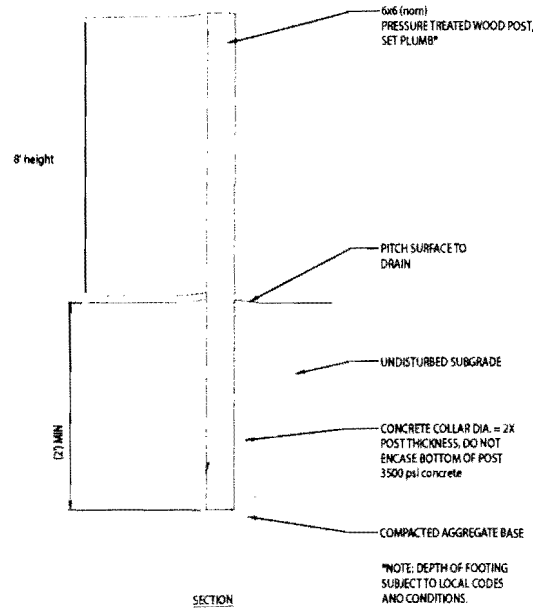


Galvanized steel "L" bracket to hang panel on cross beam

- Panels base coat individually prior to installation
- Panel joints to be filled and skimmed with fiberglass based 2 part epoxy/adhesive prior to final coating for seamless finish
- Final coating design to be determined *
