Treasurer's Report

Budget projections for 2023-24 shared - revenue and expenses from 2022-23

- Successful year with new board and amazing coordinators.

Most of funding goes to cultural arts (assemblies)- High Touch High Tech will continue to be offered next year.

The Cultural Arts committee is considering new programs in place of Extreme Science, Rhythm Room, etc.

PAC voted- Budget for 2023-2024 approved

Current School Business - Mr. Barner

Proposed- Outdoor Education opportunity- possibly 3rd or 4th week of September for 3,4,5 grade- Hale Reservation runs a program (obstacles, physical challenges, scavenger hunt, team building)- cost is higher than other assemblies we have.

- Possibly sponsored by the PAC, targeted fundraising to help pay for the program (\$10,000 for 3 grades) approx \$54 per student.
- 50/50 raffle could be an easy way to raise money for the program.
- We would have to fundraise in the summer due to timing
- PAC should vote up to a certain amount of money spent for the program?
 - PAC votes to earmark the grant money for this program

PAC Business

- Grant request from Mrs. Green- heart rate monitors and computer software online program.
 - 24 heart rate monitors (\$4200)
 - Should be logistically easy (numbered monitors per kid)
 - Are there alternative options?
 - What is the goal? To improve physical education, etc.
- Grant request standing desks x 2
 - requested by two different teachers (approx \$160 each)
 - One teacher requested a desk for personal use, another requested a desk for teacher and student use.
 - Yes but perhaps a less expensive option
 - Teacher stipends at the beginning of the year could go toward this.
 - PAC voted- Approved standing desk/table purchase for \$172
- Grant request Docent field trip
 - o \$1000 requested

- Maybe they can take some from the PAC money budgeted for next year
- o 3rd grade field trip to Decordova sculpture museum
- Would this replace a different 3rd grade field trip? Yes but not positive
- o 2nd grade teachers were not interested in the trip idea
- Maybe we could instead do an older grade?
- \$500 docent grant would offset the cost- would be mostly for the bus ride- PAC cover expense for bus
- PAC voted- Approved 3rd grade docent trip for \$1000
- PAC Board nominations vote on Secretary (move this officially to September)
 - Hannah Foley has offered to serve as Secretary
 - PAC votes to approve current board members reelection
 - Co-Presidents Margaret Rice, Jennifer Ford
 - Treasurer Kerrie Wilbur
