### OPR PAC Meeting

- Minutes from October 18, 2018 were approved with a unanimous vote

#### Treasurer report

- Apple of My Eye - profit of slightly over 1k
- Direct Donations - 1400
- Parents Night out made 6k
- SOHD (held twice) has made 2485
- Expenses so far include: sunshine committee, reading incentives

#### Mr Barner update

- When the police station was redone they donated old chairs to the school.
- The children will be participating in a “kindness challenge” which will tie into the LOL challenge this year which will also have a “kindness” theme
- Battle of the Books will kick off in December for grades 3-5 with the help of Kistra Damaso.
- Cultural arts committee consists of 4 parents and presentations are booked for the rest of the year. Includes a variety of activities per grade and 4 full school presentations including themes such as core values.
- New school security radios with all the teachers and police department sharing a channel. Anything going on in the town administrators will know about by switching to that channel. Staff are also beginning ALICE training (Alert Lockdown Inform Counter Evacuate)
- Professional Development is occurring throughout the year. It includes science curriculum development and new standards. Freckle is used in grades 3,4 and 5 where students go on and complete work that is customized to their grade level. Foundations in K and 1<sup>st</sup> for phonics and handwriting and will be rolled into 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Aspen family portal- when report cards come out they will be accessible on the portal.
- New Homework club will be starting. It will be highly structured homework or use freckle spend time on math school, videos to watch and quizzes at the end. 3 strikes for behavior or no show.
